WELCOME

Situated on a leafy lane in the parish of St Saviour, the stunning property of Chateau Vermont is run by the Jersey Academy of Music, a non-profit charitable organisation. We are seeking to welcome visiting groups to the island to accommodate in splendour and introduce to our beautiful island!



We can sleep up to forty people, spread over six en-suite bedrooms (for larger groups we operate in partnership with other nearby accommodation centres). Catering is provided on-site and can be flexibly arranged according to your group's requirements. The property also contains extensive facilities for the use of guests, including a 100-seater lecture/recital hall, 14 teaching rooms of varying sizes, a dining room, games room, and a beautiful chapel in the grounds!

Our facility can simply be utilised as an accommodation base, however for visiting musical groups we can also assist with arranging a diverse programme of concerts and collaborative educational activities during your stay, giving visiting young musicians the opportunity to collaborate with the Island's musicians. As well as utilising our concert hall, chapel, and outdoor stage for performances, we can arrange for concerts in traditional concert venues and beautiful church settings on the island. We work closely with organisations including Jersey Heritage, National Trust, Jersey Tourism and Durrell Conservation Trust, which can lead to some exciting concerts in truly spectacular locations (medieval castles, clifftop forts, and in the midst of the zoo to name but a few!).

However, the facility is open to all groups of all subjects, our Island has so much to offer visiting school groups of all ages. Consider the Island of Jersey and Chateau Vermont for your next tour destination!

BEDROOMS

Our six en-suite bedrooms can be configured in any combination, with the larger rooms for children, and the smaller rooms for supervising staff. In total we can accommodate up to forty, but smaller groups are also welcome.



CATERING

We will arrange the catering to your specification, based on your programme of activity on the island, and can adapt with flexibility to suit all budgets. The dining hall is attached to a games room with a pool table, table-football, and a wide-screen TV for movie nights!

OTHER FACILITIES

Chateau Vermont boasts a vast range of facilities for the use of visiting groups, a superb and welcoming base to call 'home' for the duration of your tour.

Ground Floor - 100-seater concert hall, large rehearsal room, and two smaller teaching rooms (all with excellent grand pianos), plus kitchen, dining room, toilets.

First floor - 6 en-suite bedrooms of varying sizes, office.

Second floor - 10 teaching rooms, two large and eight small to medium size, all with upright pianos.

Exterior - vast lawns for the enjoyment of guests, a quaint 80-seat granite Chapel, and an outdoor stage ideal for open-air performances. Ample parking.



THE ISLAND OF JERSEY

Located some 100 miles South of mainland Britain, Jersey is the most southerly of the British Isles. In fact, it's much closer to France, lying just 14 miles from its coast and therefore possessing a unique continental feel. Despite its compact size - just 9 miles by 5 miles - Jersey is gifted with a rich and varied landscape which sends visitors into sensory overload.

An island shaped by the sea where some of the most astonishing tides in the world circle the coast and feed the land. An island that's small on size, but big on personality, where country lanes open to cliff top views and the sea is never more than ten minutes away.
